Read 4 Fun's Annual Dr. Seuss Day brings joy to students in 242 classrooms across Trumbull County

On Friday, March 2, 2018, quest readers visited the classrooms of 12 school districts in Trumbull County to celebrate Dr. Seuss's birthday as part of United Way of Trumbull County's Read 4 Fun program. Due to weather conditions, six additional school districts celebrated Dr. Seuss Day throughout the month of March, making it a total of 18 school districts (242 classrooms) participating in this year's program. Over 4,800 students and approximately 120 quest readers shared many laughs and smiles while celebrating Dr. Seuss and his stories.

Read 4 Fun was developed to teach students that reading is not only for learning, but also for fun. The program is designed to build confidence and creativity through unique learning experiences and decrease the risk of students dropping out of high school by engaging them during critical learning stages.

According to a study done on America's early childhood crisis, "America's Early Childhood", research proves that when adults read to children, discuss story content, ask open-ended questions about story events, and point out features of print, they provide increased language development, comprehension of story content, knowledge of story structure and a better understanding of language - all which lead to literacy success! Having an outside guest reader come to the schools allows for new engagement and learning opportunities for students. Our guest readers take the time to ask the students guestions to further teach them the life lessons found within each Dr. Seuss book.




Willard Food Pantry Opens

Warren City Schools unveiled one of its two new Raider Food Pantries at Willard PK-8 School. The new pantries located at Willard and Jefferson PK-8 Schools are collaboration between the school district, United Way of Trumbull County, Second Harvest Food Bank & Mercy Health, and provide students in need with food/personal care items. Mayfair Laundromat generously supplied the pantries with laundry detergent. The school food pantries are designed to remove the educational barrier hunger presents to students in the district.

Michelle Chiaro, Principal of Willard PK-8 School, says the determining factors in implementing the new food pantry was the ongoing need from students and their families within the neighborhoods of Warren. The staff and administration said they explored the opportunity to open a pantry years prior and when the opportunity finally presented itself; Michelle was excited to get it opened.

The pantry is currently serving 25-27 students a day. United Way of Trumbull County interviewed Michelle Chiaro on Friday, March 23, and she explained how even with a snow day that week, the pantry was able to serve a whopping 89 students. United Way of Trumbull County is proud to support and help with the replenishing of the new food pantry as it continues to be a viable resource to students and their families.


